



LESSON HORSE PROGRAM

Greystoke Dressage is proud to offer individuals without a horse the opportunity to use a lesson horse to gain knowledge and experience in the saddle.

Introductory lesson (45 minutes to 1 hour) \$50

Includes introduction to facility, horse, grooming and tacking procedures, and safety procedures
The introductory lesson will be less riding time than a regular lesson

Single 30-minute lesson \$40

Package \$140

Four 30-minute lessons (\$35/lesson). Lessons must be used within 28 days.

Lesson Program Policies

- ❖ All riders must fill out a new client form and sign a liability waiver.
- ❖ Lessons are available Sunday through Friday. Greystoke Dressage is closed on Saturdays.
- ❖ Lessons will not be held on New Year's Day, Easter, Memorial Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas
- ❖ Clients will receive an email to create an account where they can see their scheduled lessons online at equineoffice.io
- ❖ Cancellation Policy
 - Clients will be notified by Greystoke Dressage as early as possible if cancellations must occur due to extreme heat, cold, road conditions, or conflicting events such as horse shows or holidays.
 - Package lessons canceled by Greystoke Dressage will either be rescheduled or roll-over to the next package.
 - Package lessons canceled by clients at least 24 hours before will be given a makeup lesson to be used within 14 days from the canceled lesson.
 - Cancellations by clients less than 24 hours before and no-shows will be charged at full price, no makeup lesson will be given.

- ❖ Payment due at time of service – only cash or check accepted
 - At this time, Greystoke Dressage cannot accept Venmo or Paypal
- ❖ Riders must be at least 5 years of age.
- ❖ For the first lesson, riders may wear any safe helmet available such as a bike helmet. After the first lesson, riders must have an ASTM/SEI certified riding helmet.
- ❖ Riders must wear long pants and closed-toed shoes with a heel. Gloves are strongly recommended.
- ❖ Riders must arrive at least 15 minutes before their scheduled lesson time to tack up their horse and expect to stay at least 15 minutes (longer if necessary) to cool out and untack their horse and clean up equipment. Lesson times will only be extended for late arrivals if time allows.

- ❖ To comply with Safe Sport and US Equestrian's Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies, students under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a parent/guardian or have a signed form of consent filed with Greystoke Dressage. New consent forms must be signed every six months.
